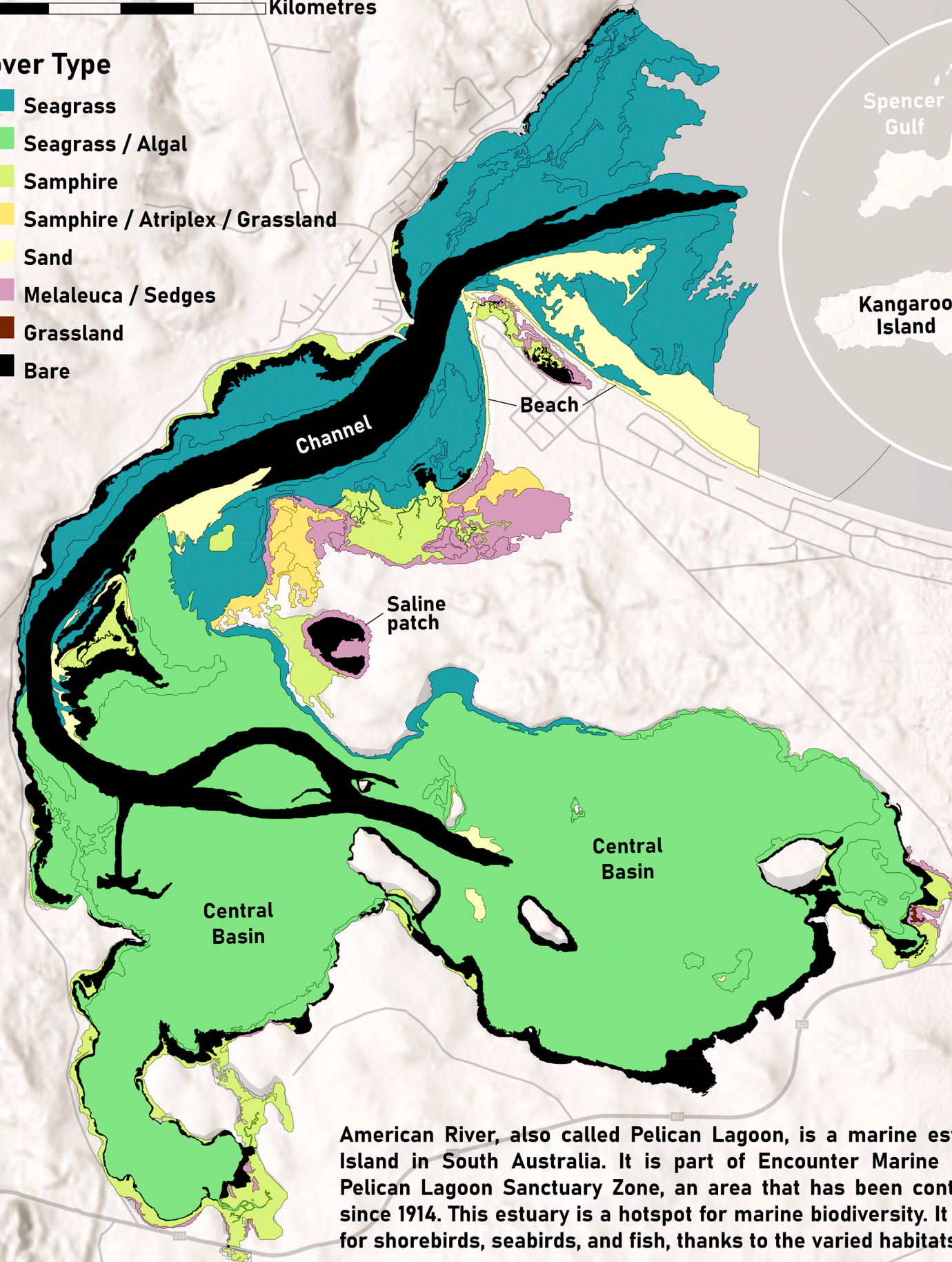

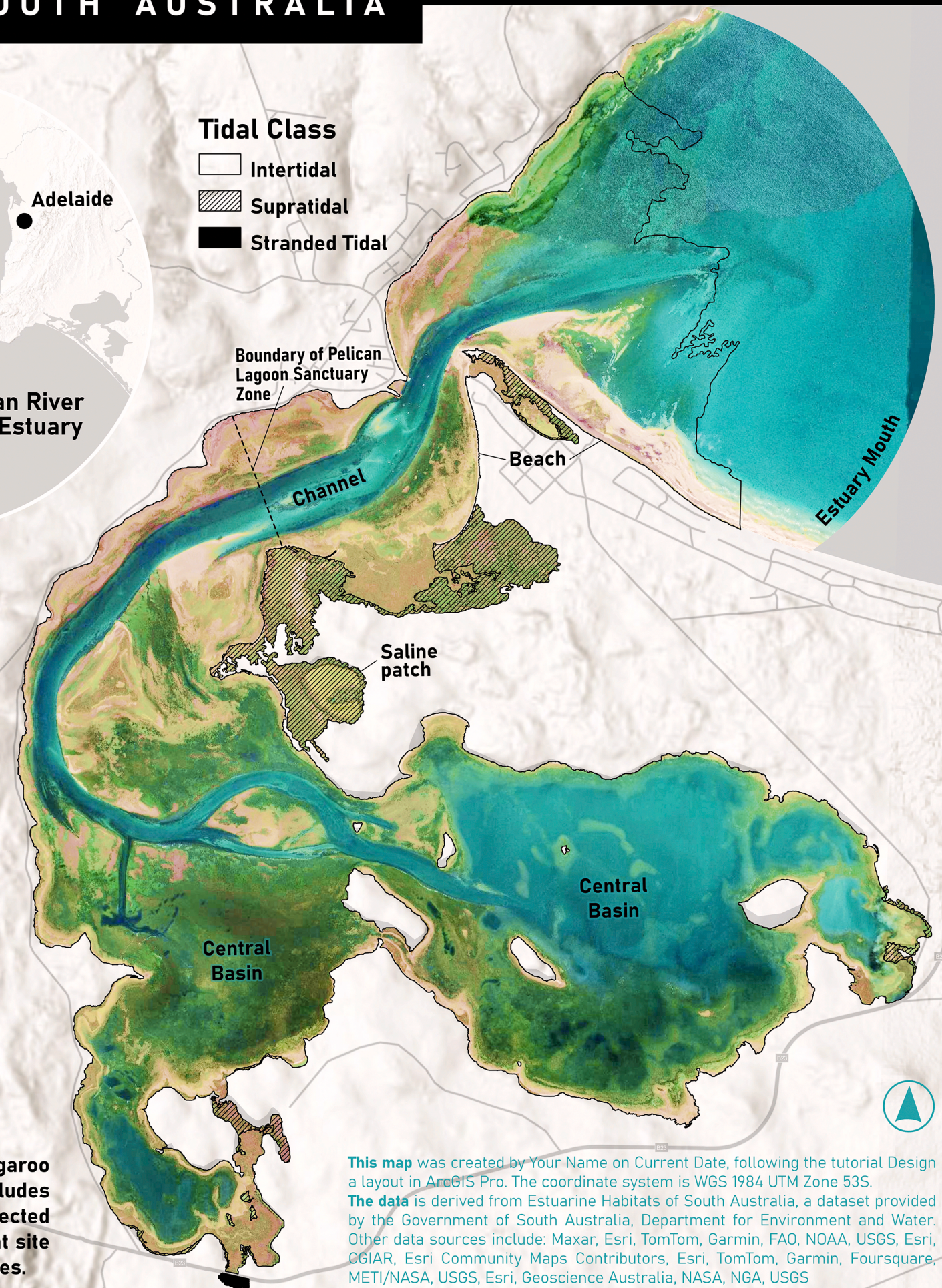

It is a significant site for shorebirds, seabirds, and fish, thanks to the varied habitats that it provides.
